Dear Valued Client.

Beginning in January 1997 the Bureau of Export Administration (BXA) required all exporters and agents (forwarders) to enter a "Destination Control Statement" on the shipping documents for all exports from the United States.

The responsibility for assuring that the "Destination Control Statement" is used on the commercial invoice falls on the exporter, whether the exporter actually prepares this document or if the invoice is prepared by an order party or agent.

We, as agents, share this responsibility and are required to notify exporters in writing when 1) we receive commercial invoices without the correct "Destination Control Statement" and 2) request written assurance from the exporter that this statement will be properly entered on all copies of the commercial invoice.
